WP5. Spread out Innovative Educational Model

*WP5 ensured the visibility, dissemination, and continuous improvement of project results, supporting the uptake and scalability of the **Innovative Educational Model**. Partners collaboratively developed and maintained the project website, promotional materials, and the Moodle e-platform, providing structured access to theoretical and practical green education resources and blended learning sessions.*

Multiplier events (ME1: Bucharest, ME2: Ruse, ME3: San Secondo di Pinerolo) enabled teachers, trainers, students, and practitioners to exchange good practices, provide feedback, and enhance transnational collaboration. Follow-up and improvement measures captured structured feedback from testing (2023–2024) and adjusting (2024–2025) phases, including learning sessions, practitioner-focused activities, and TAs (TA1–TA5), supporting iterative refinement of curricula and educational resources.

The Good Practice Guide (D5.3) documented project aims, partner contributions, and the assessment of direct beneficiaries, highlighting learner engagement, skills development, and the progressive impact of the project.

Overall, WP5 strengthened stakeholder engagement, ensured quality assurance, and maximised the accessibility, relevance, and long-term impact of project outputs, fostering cross-disciplinary knowledge exchange and supporting Europe's green and digital transition.
